



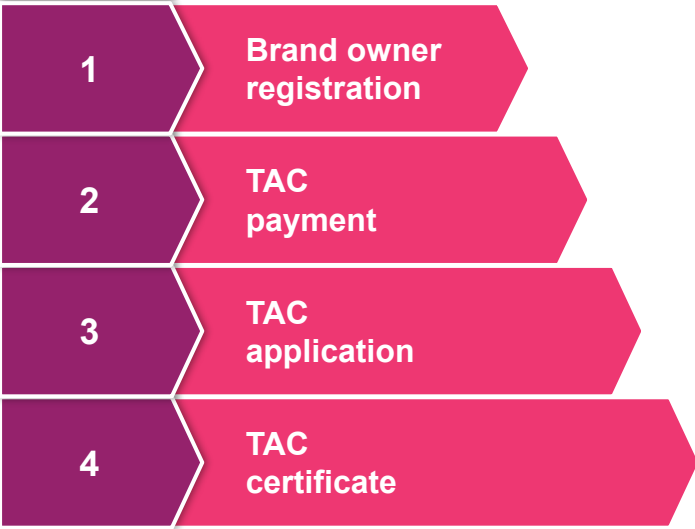

of charge.

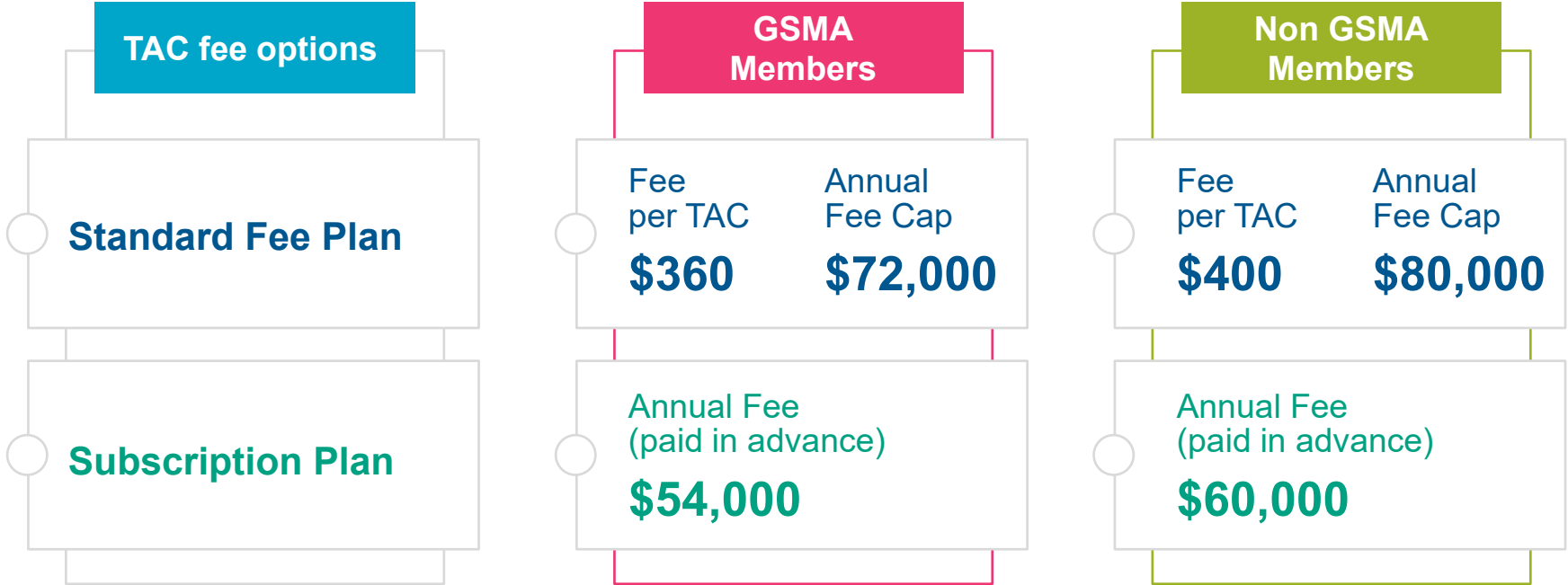
Subscription Plan

You will need to wait until payment is complete before being able to **request TAC**





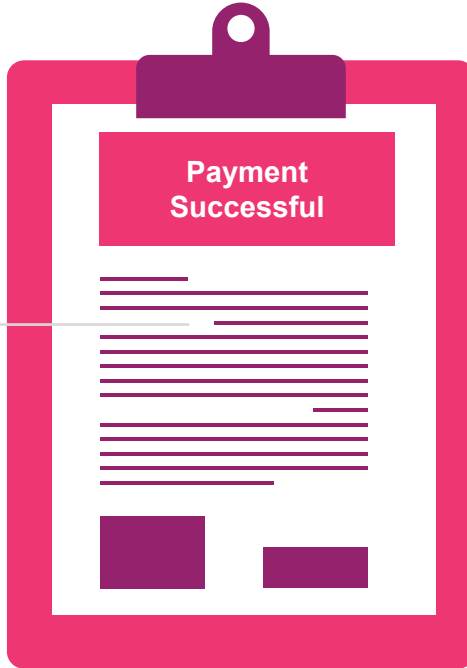

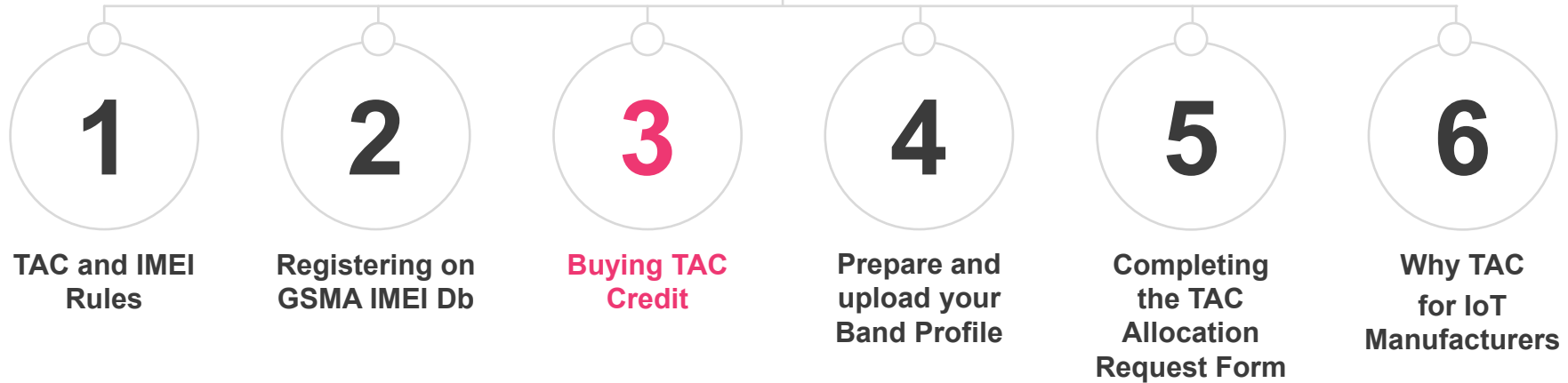
